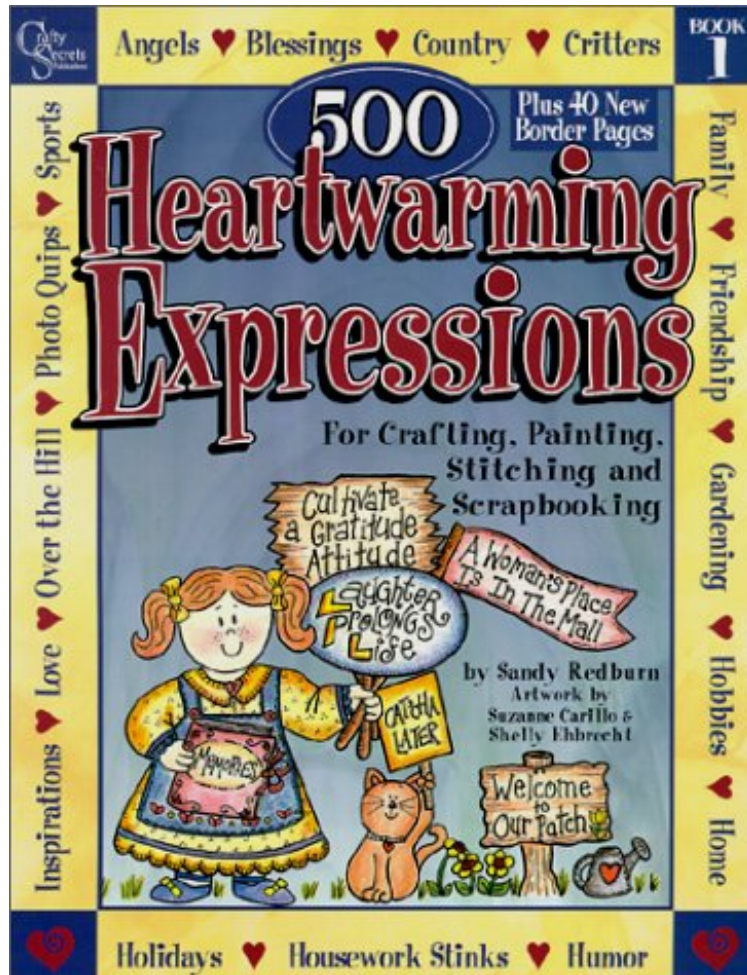

This first book in the Heartwarming Expressions series has been newly revised and now includes 500 hand-lettered expressions with 40 new whimsical border pages added to match the themes. These heartfelt phrases, humorous quips and inspirational quotes can be used to create special cards, gifts, scrapbook pages, seasonal crafts, home decor projects and keepsakes for family and loved ones, new friends, old friends and those angels in life. Although the biggest buyers of the books are now scrapbookers, everyone likes the fact that the books are so versatile. Each book includes lettering tips and tricks for using pens and markers, a paintbrush, needle and thread, or tracing and photocopying the expressions and illustrations. If you get stuck for ideas, the inside cover of every book includes a list of 99 Places to Put an Expression. You don't have to drive yourself crazy anymore trying to think up the right words. All three books each include life's most popular themes, such as family, friendship, holidays, home, inspiration, love, over the hill, photo quips and more. Book #1 also has extra expressions for doll lovers, inspiration, stitching and quilting, and teaching. Book # 1 also now includes a list with 40 ways to add more joy to life.
