Contains 52 woodworking projects, ranging from the very simple to the intermediate, including a push cart, hobby horse and doll's cradle. Colour photographs are provided, along with two-view drawings and section views of special details.

From BooklistGet ready to empty out that scrap bin, for here's a book that aids the casual woodworker in creating toys and puzzles for children and grandchildren. Most of the projects are very easy, although a couple require some patience. It's very nice to see the number of historic toys depicted, some of them dating from as far back as 1880, so that the book goes well beyond the rocking horse and wooden train found in most toy-making texts and on to such unique toys as "bobbing chickens" and a "walking seesaw." You will need a complete set of woodworking skills to accomplish all 52 projects, but novices can easily do quite a few. This book is a winner and, with the holidays looming, should find its way into many home workshops. Jon Kartman
