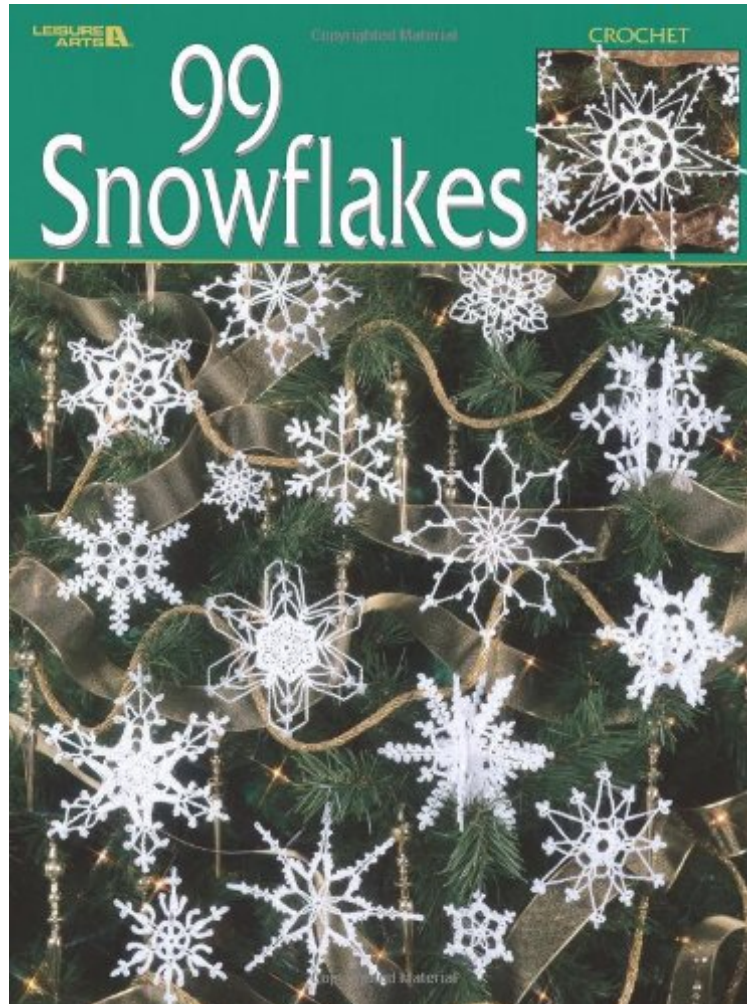

There are about 10-15 unique, interesting designs per book, and the rest of them are basically things you've seen if you've made snowflake ornaments before. The funniest thing about these books and the reason for 4 stars instead of 5 is that the blocking is awful in the sample photos. I find myself shaking my head amused at how little effort and attention the sample-makers put into actually blocking the things, which, of course, is the single most important step to creating a finished piece. But don't let it deter you. If you pay attention to your own blocking, you'll have some truly lovely ornaments. 3 of 3 people found the

The patterns are very simple and there wasn't anything in here that I couldn't have made up myself without the help of a pattern. I have found many more wonderful flake patterns on the web for free. I tried a few patterns and had to fix several errors where the writer did not use techniques that would have produced a much more symmetrical design. The book does not even show the flakes after blocking and stiffening. Crocheted flakes take on a much more magical look when blocked and stiffened so I was disappointed to see this missing.
