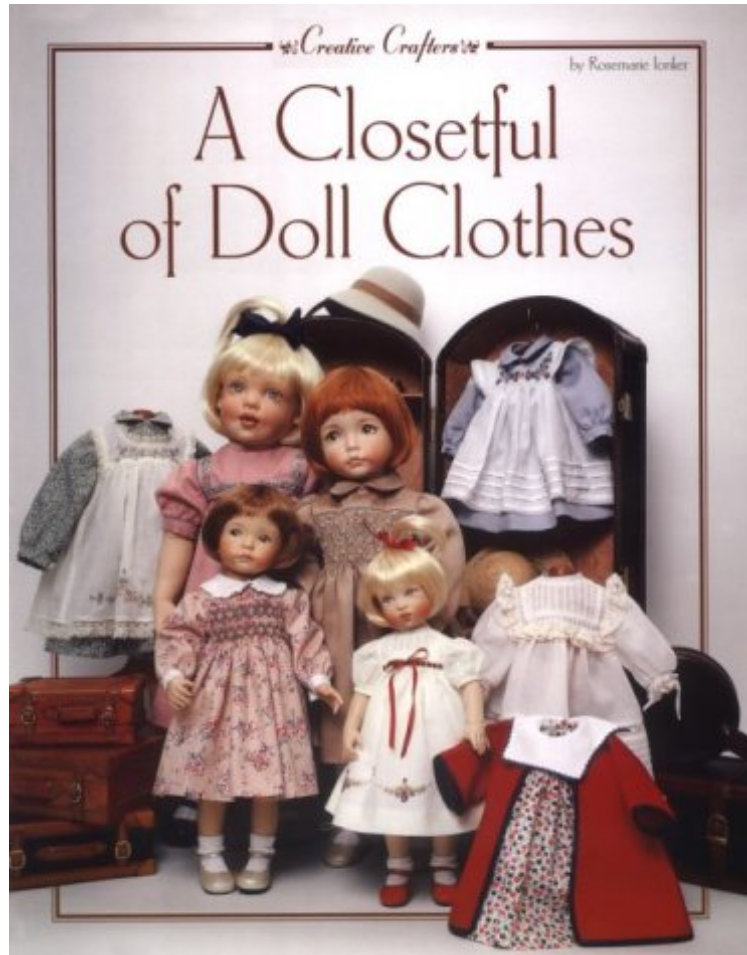

The patterns are adjustable for dolls of four sizes, ranging from 11 1/2 to 20 inches. Dolls by well-known artists Helen Kish and Diana Effner model the completed outfits in stunning color photography, which includes detail shots of the embroidery and smocking that distinguishes Ionker's designs.
