Yes, I saw the video of the pages first, and knew exactly how many pages existed under each heading before purchasing, I personally love this book, and have rated it 4 stars for a lot of great reasons. However, there are suggestions I would like to make. This is a wonderful tool, a long time coming for us colorists. PLEASE use pencil on your lists, Things change, and you can erase items and be able to use those lines again. With all that said, here are the suggestions I would like to make. There are ample pages to list MY COLORING BOOKS on hand, as well as your COLORING BOOK WISH LIST. Now, there are also pages for your "FAVORITE COLORING BOOKS". I would make the assumption that one's favorite books will either already be on the list you already own OR on your book wish list. On your current list or wish list, you can add a STAR by which ones are your favorites. With that said, I would make a change to the title of this list. Instead of calling it "FAVORITE COLORING

BOOKS", how about calling it "FAVORITE COLORING PRODUCTS"? On this list, you can now list all products you love and would recommend, including favorite pencils and markers, sharpeners, NOT JUST BOOKS. The next change I would make is to the title of "COLORING BOOKS WISH LIST"; I would change that to "COLORING PRODUCTS WISH LIST". This way, you can not only add the books you desire, but also the markers, pencils or gel pens or storage accessories you are eyeing that you do not yet have. (There ARE pages to list the coloring supplies you own, but not a wish list for those supplies, the change to the title of the wish list would cover everything, so this problem is solved.) The next thing I would mention is that this type of book could have been double sided, giving us DOUBLE the pages to list favorites, etc. (Now I know that the only place this would not work is on the coloring charts, you need single sided pages for marker swatches.) However, if the pages were double-sided, you'd have extra pages for pencil swatches, as some people own over 500 pencils. Once you are ready to add your marker swatches, you leave the back side of those pages blank, but you still would have extra pages for swatches. Another reason for double-sided pages, you could make the spaces between lines a teeny bit wider. These are fine for me, but some people will have trouble listing things tiny and/or reading them afterwards. The lines are very narrow! All in all, this is still a GREAT product. I will use whiteout and a black marker to change the name of those pages I mentioned. I may also trace lines on the back of color swatch pages to add more spaces for pencils swatches. 8 of 9 people found the following review helpful.
