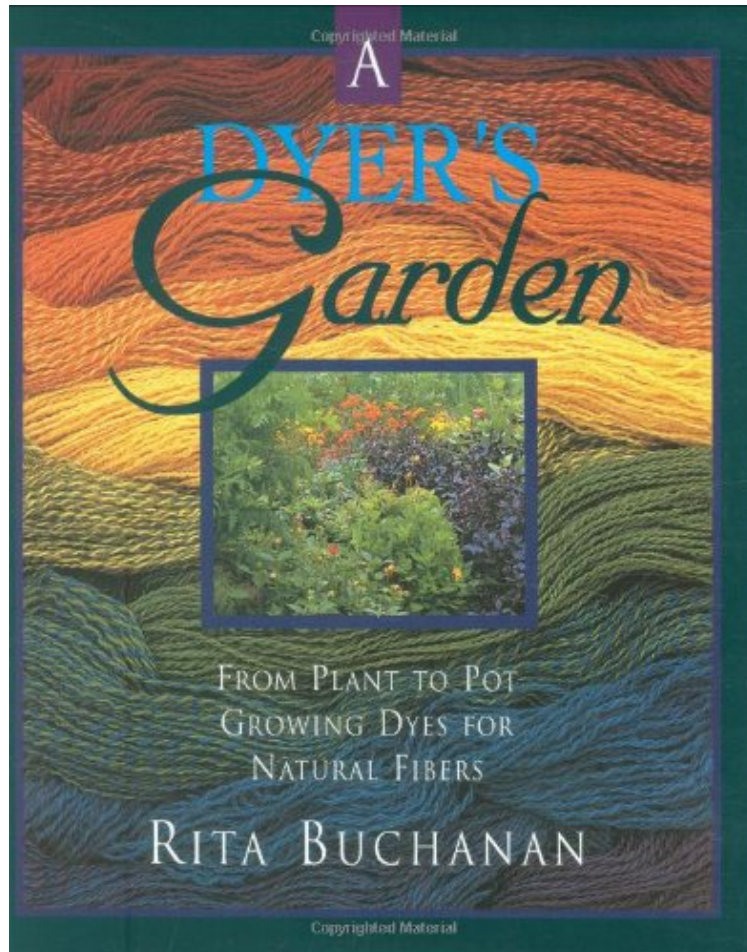

By mel rose This is a small, pocket-sized book, but it packs quite a bit of good info inside the covers. Instead of focusing on the colors, it focuses on the plant. Each plant has a page where instructions for growing it and similar species are discussed. There's a page with the colors to be expected when used on a number of materials. I wish that it had a bit more depth, but it is an excellent addition to a dyers library.

Touching on the history and nature of dye plants, this comprehensive guide walks readers through a garden season from design to planting to harvesting for the dyepot, discussing 18 dye plants in detail.
