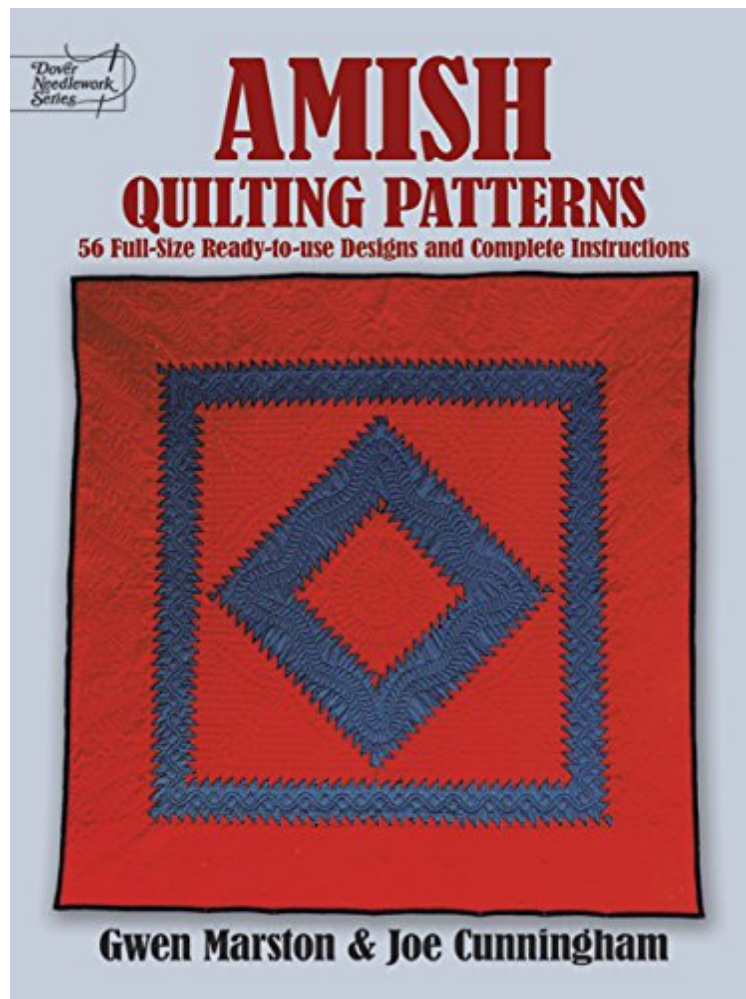

There are patterns for inner and outer borders, center panels, and plain blocks. The patterns vary in size which is helpful when you want a ready-to-go border or central panel motif. For example, five patterns for the cable border motif are provided, ranging in size from 3" to 7".

The patterns could easily be enlarged or reduced using a photocopier. The pattern plates can be removed from the book, if desired, to more easily trace them onto either the quilt fabric directly, or onto your choice of template material (freezer paper, mylar, etc.) This is a pattern book, so do not expect detailed instructions on how to make patterns, choose tools, or prepare your quilt for quilting, although these subjects are included in the short chapter "General Instructions for Quilting"/ I would recommend either "Flawless Hand Quilting" published by Rodale, or the encyclopedic "Quiltmaking by Hand, Simple Stitches, Exquisite Quilts", by Jinny Beyer for detailed hand quilting information. Complete detailsBy GeorginaThis book gives complete details on HAND QUILTING your Amish quilt and some general information about the colour/quilting/pattern combinations in black and white line drawings. Discusses the threads, batting thicknesses, how to copy the patterns, and includes information about quilting frames for a full roundup on the quilting scene. As for which pattern to use with which type of quilt, the book breaks down the differences between the Lancaster PA Amish and the Midwestern Amish. Remember though this is geared all towards HAND quilting. For Machine Quilting see the Dover Pub, Amish Patterns for Machine Quilting which adapts these hand patterns for machines. Really quite a nice book for the price.
