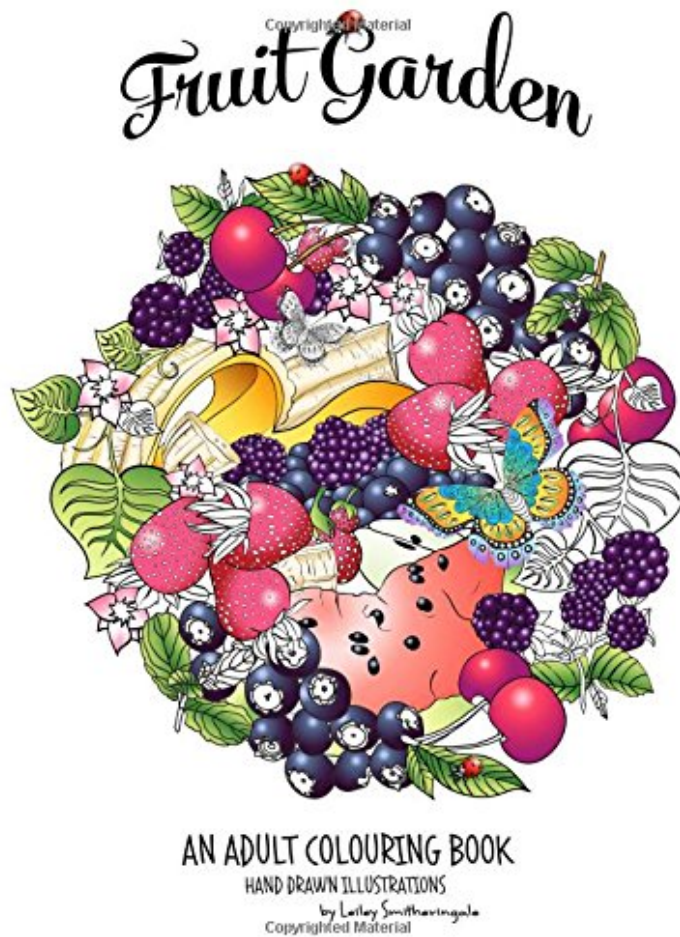

It's fabulous how Lesley has included in the book "Colouring tips Techniques" and digital examples of how

these designs can be coloured. I also love the fact that there's also a practice sheet which is a fabulous idea to print off as often as you like to try out different techniques or different mediums combinations before you start on your actual design page. After thoroughly going through the whole book, I must say each page is a well designed interesting composition appealing to the eye. A personal favourite of mine is the apple blossoms butterflies page - you also have a choice of both standard line art greyscale with this one too. Certainly some designs have a lot of detail, which I don't mind at all while others are less complicated and most likely quicker to complete. One of My Favorite Books By Nan Mercer I recently purchased and received Fruit Garden: An Adult Colouring Book by Lesley Smitheringale. Lesley has hand-drawn all of the illustrations, which are reminiscent of the still-life style. And what wonderful coloring book it is! This book contains 32 pages. Lesley includes several informational pages, including an about the author page and a practice page that includes some of the fruit illustrations from the book. I really like that feature because I could try out the colors I wanted to use in the book and each of the three brands I tried look really beautiful. Lesley's illustrations, the coloring and blending produce fruits that appear luscious and edible. Each illustration is on a single side, have a black and a white background on adjacent pages, and a border around them. The paper is a soft creamy white. It takes color well and colored pencils blend easily, I tried three brands (Prisma Premier, Faber-Castell Polychromos, and Tom Bow Irojiten.) They are not perforated but can be easily removed since the illustrations do not spread across the page and into the binding. Lesley includes a link to her website where she provides a blending guide PDF for information and practice. It is very helpful. In addition, Lesley has both a website and a Facebook page where one can get even more coloring hints. I am fairly new to the adult coloring world and almost all of my previous books are floral. I also love fruit pictures so I was really happy to find Lesley's book. It is all I hoped it would be! I bought this coloring book along with several other books and the complete set of Irojiten pencils. I was not solicited or compensated in any way for this review. The opinions expressed in this review are my own. Please note that the blending guide does often a set of free coloring pictures if she is notified that a review is given. Thanks for reading my review and I hope you decide to purchase Fruit Garden. If you like fruit and/or still-life pictures, I think you will enjoy working in this book.
