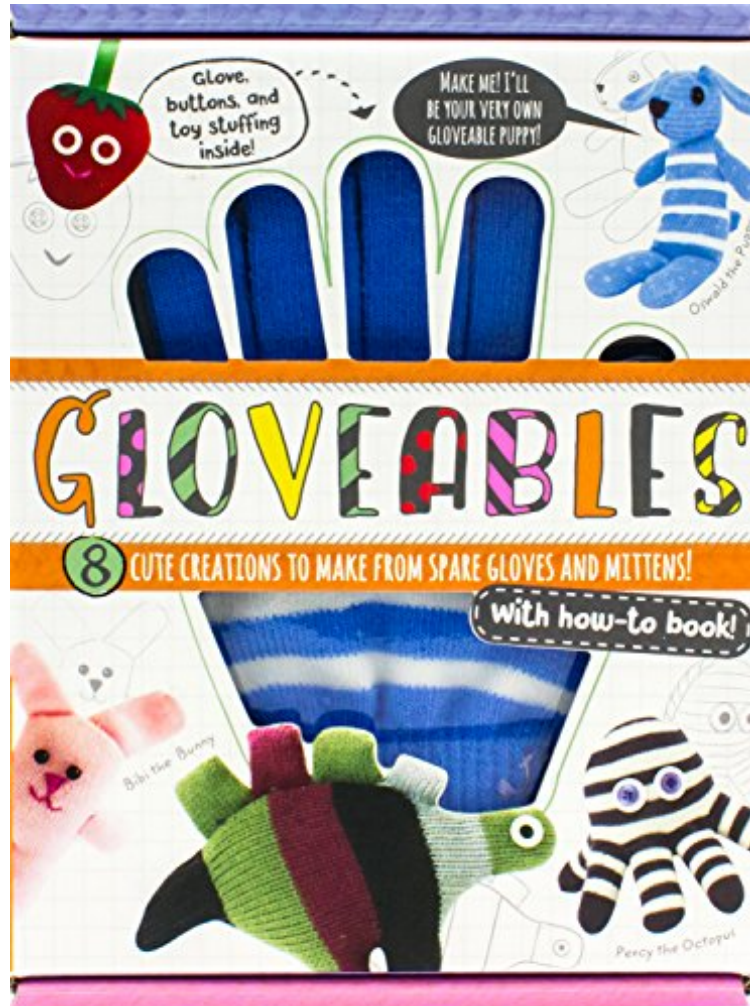

Extra supplies needed and lots of patience!By Gerri T.My 8 yr old neighbor enlisted me to help him make one of these, it was a gift from Santa. I've been a sewer and crafter for over 35 yrs and it still took me almost 3 hours to complete the blue dog. This kit is a really cute idea, the book has great patterns, but don't expect a young child to be able to help much with the construction. The only thing my young friend could do was help with stuffing the body. And make sure you have extra supplies on hand, such as pillow stuffing, needle and thread, embroidery floss or yarn. The amount of stuffing enclosed was only enough to properly stuff the body of the dog, nothing else. It would have been quite a disappointment for this little boy if I didn't have extra in my stash. The instructions are a little tricky, but

anyone with sewing skills would be able to grasp it. I ended up using my sewing machine for the stitchwork... I don't think hand sewing on a knitted mitten would secure the seams enough to handle the filling. The kit only includes 1 mitten, so don't expect to make any of the patterns that require 2, which is most of them. This kit is recommended for ages 3 and up, I seriously doubt that the author has any small children to test it out. There is no way that any 3 or 4 yr old would have the fine motor skills to handle any of this construction. Hope this review helps anyone looking to purchase this kit for a rainy day activity. Just be prepared to do most, if not all, of the work yourself! The directions tell you to do things like a ladder stitch and a back stitch. I don't know how to do that. I can sew on a button. It also tells you to use embroidery thread like I have that laying around. It's not for a novice even though the box recommends it for 3 and up.

It's super-easy to turn old gloves and old mittens into cute creations. Make an adorable puppy, sew a strawberry charm, or create a mini hedgehog pincushion. Inside find 1 glove, 2 buttons, toy stuffing and book. Follow the clear instructions in the how-to book to transform spare gloves and mittens into 8 lovely friends!
