Mayhem Molasses Crinkles 3/4 c. shortening 2 c. powdered sugar 1 c. molasses 1 egg, beaten 4 c. all-purpose flour 2 t. baking soda 1 t. salt 1 t. cinnamon 2 t. ground ginger 1 t. vanilla extract
Garnish: sparkling sugar
In a large bowl, blend together shortening, powdered sugar, molasses and egg. Add remaining ingredients except garnish; stir until blended. Roll into one-inch balls, dip in sparkling sugar and place on ungreased baking sheets. Bake at 350 degrees for 10 to 12 minutes, until cookies crack. Cool. Makes 5 doz.
