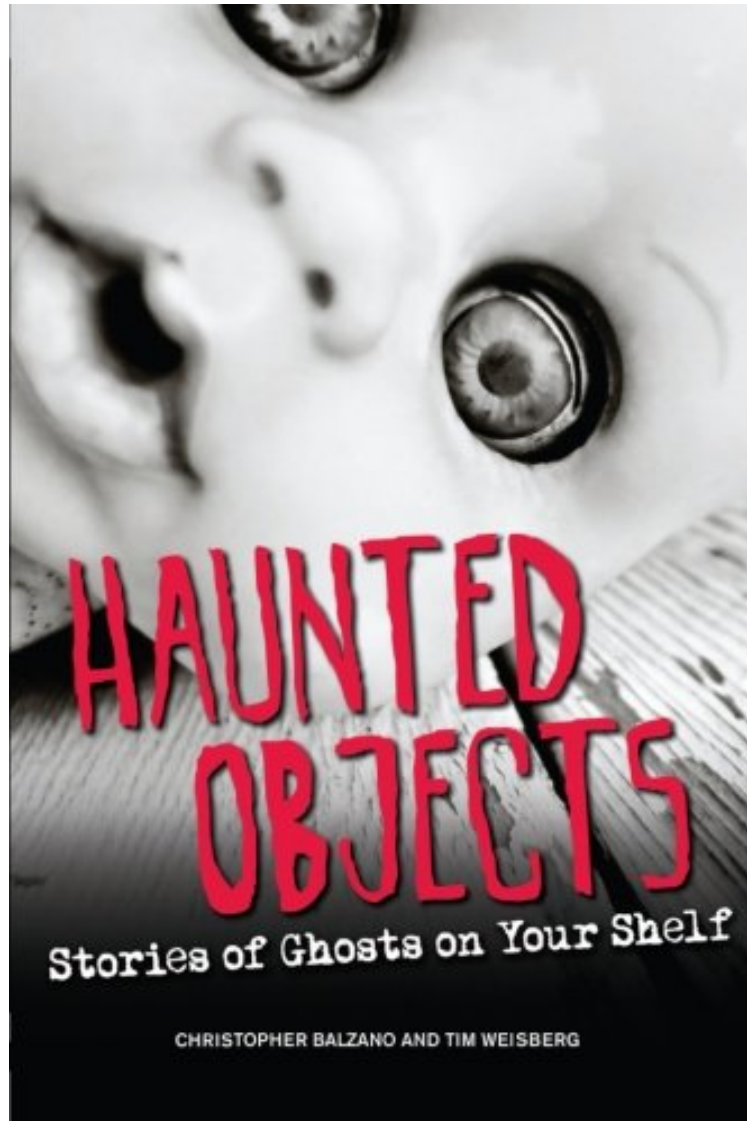

historical material and back stories present were quite extensive and informative. Some stories were rather creepy and others were same old, same old but I found myself much better informed about some of the more famously haunted objects when I was finished with this book than I had when I finished a previous book on the subject "Haunted by the Things You Love" by John Zaffis which dealt more with lesser known everyday objects from garage sales, auctions, and antique shops. One of the only complaints I had for this book and it seems to be the case with many paranormal books these days is that it was too short and needed additional material added to make some of the stories more intellectually filling. Perhaps the author should consider publishing a second edition in the future with more recent information added. Most of the haunted object 'stories' are short hearsay and legend bits that go into very little detail of what supposedly actually happened. The entire book is basically just a light overview of stories and rumors that one might hear around a campfire. Also, all the unnecessary 'filler' pictures and large quotes on the sides of the pages to make the book appear longer are very amateurish and just plain annoying. I've read many, many collections of real-life paranormal accounts (including the other books by these co-authors) and other non-fiction books don't have the literary quality that this one does. Dipping into this book is like dipping into a collection of short stories. So this book is both entertaining and surprisingly full of interesting insights into claims of haunted objects. Again, these authors clearly did their homework, and have a great deal to share about possible explanations for allegedly haunted objects. It makes a great read whether you're looking for up-to-date paranormal theory, or just looking for a spine-tingling read!
