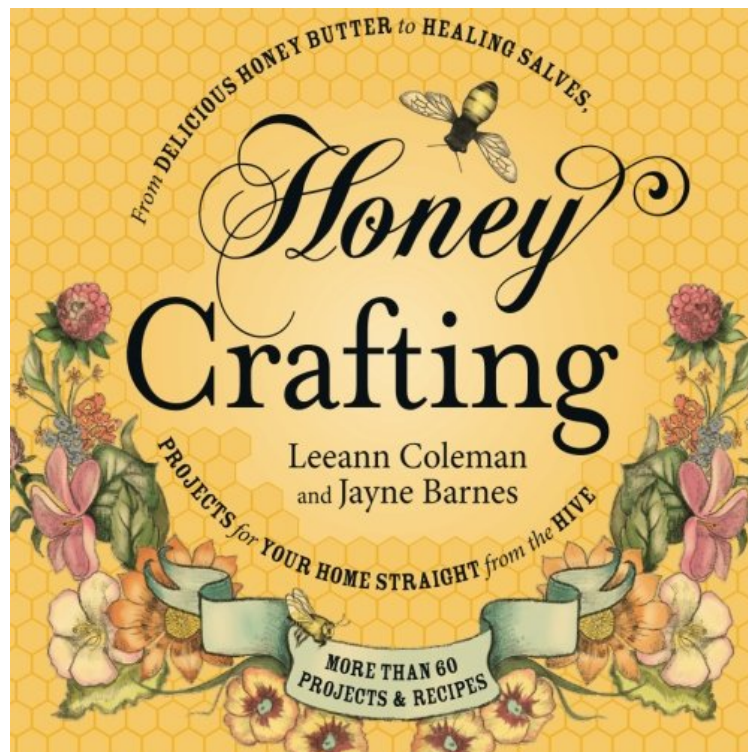

No punches are pulled, and descriptions of what could happen if done the wrong way are matter of fact, without scaring the reader.From the Kindle edition, I wish there were more photos to show in process and end results, but it works. The other issue I wish was pointed out was how the properties of honey can change when heated.
