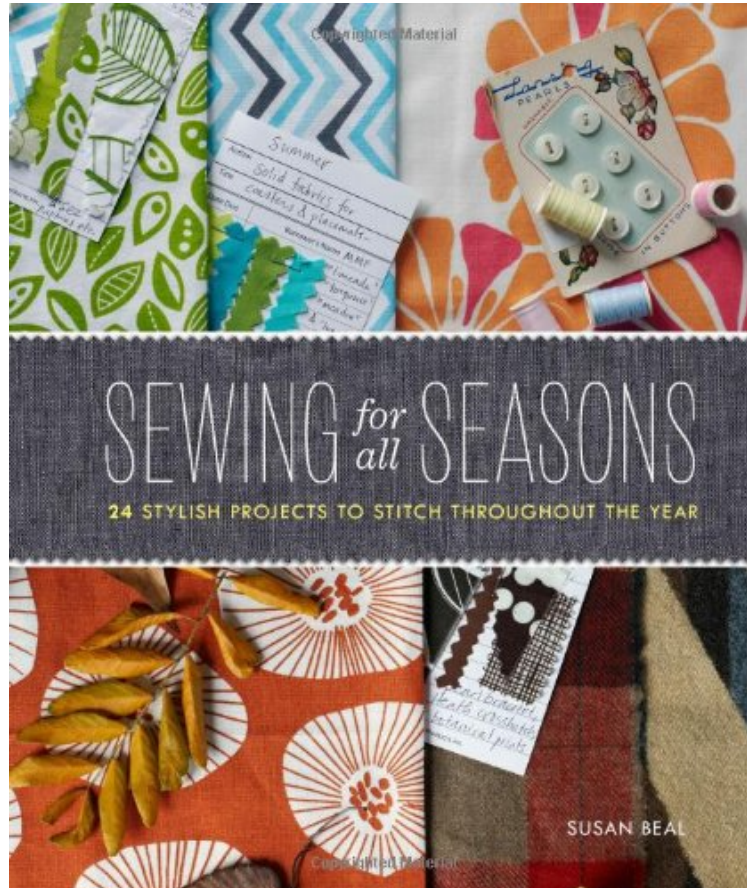

The bigger projects (gorgeous quilts and the ADORABLE Cute-As-A-Button Handbag) alone are worth the price of the book. I'm also a huge fan of Susan's method for binding her quilt projects. I was first introduced to it in her Modern Log Cabin Quilting book, and am glad to see she also shares it in Sewing for all Seasons. I've made several quilts where I have her book out and at the ready on my sewing table or ironing board so I can follow her steps for binding. Susan has a beautiful aesthetic that shows in all her projects, and Storey publishing has created a gorgeous, hard-bound book to showcase her work.
