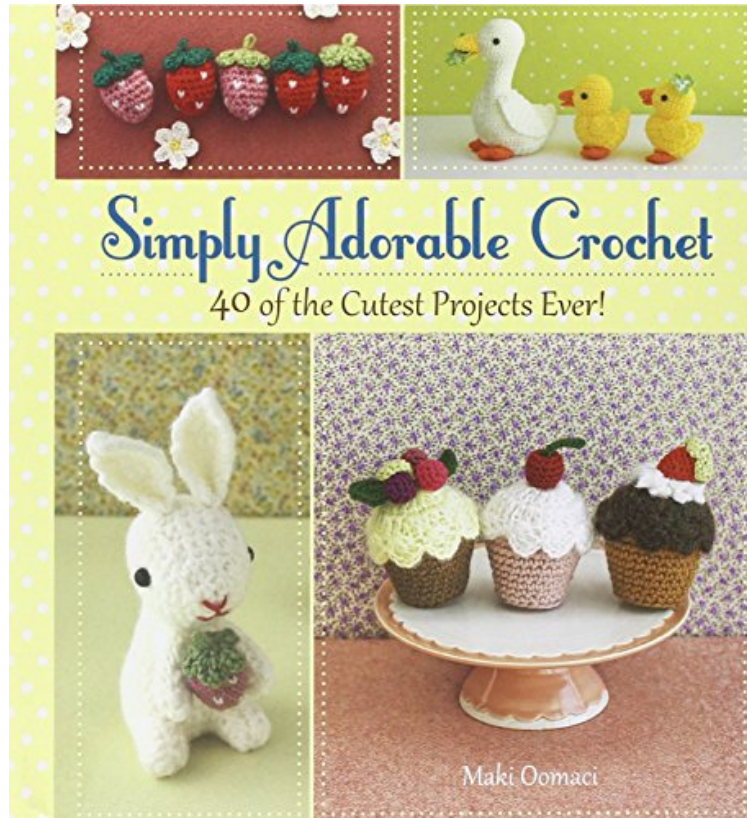

I haven't made any of the amigurumi yet, but I will soon! I have noticed that some of the amigurumi look different because they are not done "in the round" method. It is worth every penny because you get 40 beautiful and creative patterns. There are even Christmas patterns in this book. *Update* There are some pattern errors in the deer pattern. The information for the inner and outer ear are switched around in parts. This will definitely cause frustration for people who are beginners. By d. linn The items in this book are adorable but if you are used to making them in the round this could get confusing, not to mention there is a lot of sewing and weaving ends. It should have been edited better. There are mistakes, the deer pattern has the ears switched. Inner is outer pattern. It also will tell you to repeat rows 3-12, then in the next sentence tell you to break yarn on row 10. So you will have to go with your instinct. A complete beginner might have trouble. It is a beautiful book, with lovely photography and being spiral bound it lays flat when you are working.
