PerrottaThe plot of the story is interesting and well-orchestrated, the character development is good and there are tons of frights and surprises that make you want to keep turning the page. However, I had to do a lot of skimming and I mean a lot. This book was in dire need of editing as the descriptions are endless and usually unnecessary. As soon as something good starts to happen, the author gets so

bogged down with the details of a new scene (how many lanes a road has, the types of construction going on, the exact process of how someone wipes himself with toilet paper etc. etc. ) the flow of the plot is almost always driven to a near stop. This is maddening. I like details as much as the next reader but too much is too much! I think this author got paid by the word and had an extremely thorough thesaurus which he used in nearly every paragraph he wrote. Could have been condensed to half its volume and really kept readers on edge instead of constantly taking them to a climax and then letting them fall with boring, endless narratives that have you skimming for dialogue hoping he'll lead you back to the point where you actually cared. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
