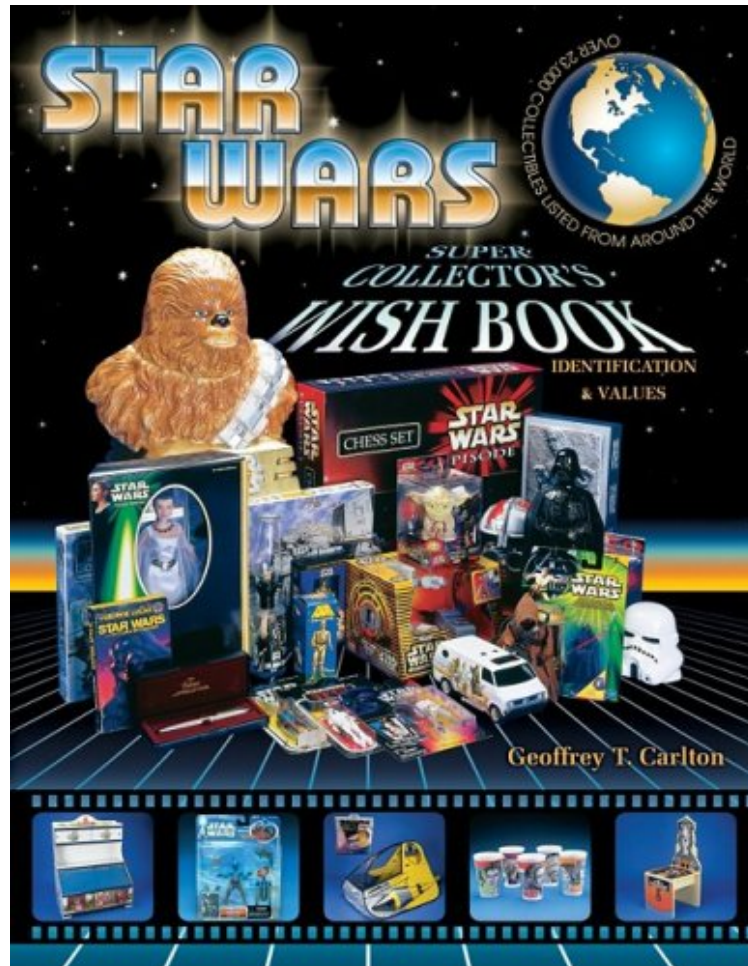

Also, why the author split up the action figure stuff all over the book is a mystery. A quarter of the 384 pages is devoted to Star Wars trading cards of one form or another. I would rather have seen larger pictures of some of the other items than pages and pages of trading cards. Finally I know it is VERY difficult to price these sort of collectibles but at the very least there are

certain key things which should be researched. If you were to go by the prices in this book you would be left thinking the entire bottom had fallen out of the Star Wars collecting market. No offense but these prices are just going to cause a bunch of arguments between collectors and dealers (I am the former)...On the bright side it is hard to put a book like this together and I salute the layout person for doing a commendable job of scanning and color correcting so many pics.
